Qur'an Reading for Beginners

Course Description

Qur'an Reading for Beginners is a basic course designed for people who want to learn how to recite the Qur'an. No prior knowledge of the Arabic alphabet is required. Qur'an reading will be taught by the phonetic method and emphasis will be placed on recognition of the alphabet and its structures, proper pronunciation, fluent reading and basic rules of tajwid. Students will also be taught basic Arabic writing skills. Note that this is an intensive course and students are expected to attend all of the classes in order to be successful.

Course Content

Part 1: After completing the following students will graduate into the Qur'an: Studying of the Arabic alphabet, single and joined letters with vowels, vowels sounds joined by other letters, vowel sounds ending with n-sounds, duration of sounds, reading of silent letters, rules for stops, doubled letters. Each lesson will open with the recitation of surah al-Fatihah and its meaning and consist of consolidation of the previous week's work, new lessons, group reading, individual reading and closing with the recitation of surah wal-Asr and its meaning. Learners will then graduate into reading from the Qur'an.

Part 2: This part of the course will be conducted during the second half of the year. It will comprise of reading the 30th juz with fluency and correct tajwid and later memorization of some of the surahs.

Course Notes

All Qur'an readers and notes will be supplied.

Assessments

Assessments will be conducted regularly and will take the form of recitations, written work and memorization.

Who Should Attend?

This course is ideal for parents of the Madrasah who want to assist their children during the week as well as for Madrasah teachers teaching the foundation phase.

Anyone who wants to learn how to read the Qur'an with correct tajwid can also attend (no prior knowledge of the Arabic alphabet required).

Graduation

In order to graduate in this course all Qur'an Readers must be completed, as well as all assignments and external assessments as well as both parts of the course.

Qur'an Reading Fluency for Beginners

Course Description

This course is designed for students who are able to read the Qur'an but who want to improve their reading fluency and application of the tajwid rules. Students are expected to attend all of the classes in order to achieve maximum benefit of this course. Students will be able to complete a large portion of a khatam, memorise some of the shorter surahs and will be introduced to some of the sciences of the Qur'an.

Course Outcome

At the end of this course students will be able to read the Qur'an fluently and confidently with tajwid rules, and students would have learnt good habits of spending time with the Qur'an.

Assessments

Assessments will be conducted regularly and will take the form of recitations, written work and memorization.

Graduation

In order to graduate in this course all assignments and assessments must be completed.

Prerequisite

Those interested in attending this course **must** be able to **read** the **Qur'an**.

Qur'an Reading Fluency for Intermediate Readers

Course Description

This course is designed for students who attended the Qur'an Reading Fluency for Beginners class and is a continuation of the beginners class.

Students are expected to attend all of the classes in order to achieve maximum benefit of this course.

Course Outcome

At the end of this course students will be able to read the Qur'an fluently and confidently with tajwid rules, and students would have learnt good habits of spending time with the Qur'an. They would have completed a full khatam of the Qur'an.

Assessments

Assessments will be conducted regularly and will take the form of recitations, written work and memorization.

Graduation

In order to graduate in this course all assignments and assessments must be completed.

Prerequisite

Those interested in attending this course **must** be able to **read** the **Qur'an**.
